1.0 CALL TO ORDER

President Judy Holzapfel called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.

3.0 NEW BUSINESS

A. Adoption of Expulsion Handbook

Gene Massa explained that the Expulsion Handbook was part of the board policies.

Gene Massa made a motion to accept the Expulsion Handbook as written. Catherine Hanes seconded the motion. Motion was unanimous.

Superintendent Barrera has received some communications regarding the scheduled hearing date of January 15, 2010 selected by the board at their regular board meeting. He received an e-mail via GCOE attorney Janna Lambert from Matt Juhl-Darlington indicating that Willows Unified School District could not attend the hearing. Mr. Darlington has also conveyed this to attorney Chuck Michel. January 25, 2010 would be a better date for Darlington. Superintendent Barrera wanted to be sure that all parties had an opportunity to be heard. Roy Combs recommended that more information be


gathered on the nature of Mr. Darlington's conflict for January 15. Additional available dates provided by Matt Juhl-Darlington were considered by the board. The dates offered by Darlington were 1/20 and 1/21, 1/25-1/27, and 1/29/10. It was determined that January 28, 2010 was the last date possible for the hearing and still remain within the 20 day limit. It was decided to have Mr. Combs and Mr. Barrera inquire about the reason for the date conflict of January 15. Mr. Barrera would like to have clarification on whether it is Mr. Darlington or Willows School District that has the date conflict. This needs to be done as quickly as possible in the best interest of the student and the public.

B. Training on Expulsion Appeals

Roy Combs gave a PowerPoint presentation training on Expulsion Appeals for the board.
