## High School Graduation Requirements

Adult students may earn credits toward high school graduation by taking course work through the Glenn County Adult Education Program. An adult student may receive a diploma awarded by the Glenn County Office of Education only after completing the prescribed course of study and meeting the standards of proficiency established. All students are required to pass the California High School Exit Exam. This exam is administered to the student free of charge.
