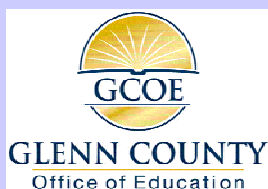

- *CaliforniaStreaming* offers great videos, podcasts, lesson plans and more. Go to the LMC website, scroll down to the *CaliforniaStreaming* link, and log-on to search by standard, grade level, and/or subject. Content changes daily, so keep checking back if you don't find what you are looking for. Call Anna for your passcode if you have not yet set up an account.
- EBSCO is your one-stop resource for research needs. These are carefully chosen databases (newspapers and magazine articles, dictionary, encyclopedia, etc.) allowing you and your students access from any computer with internet capability to the highest quality research resources for schools.
