ALL GRADUATES

Johns Manville Scholarship: The Johns Manville, Inc., manufacturer of quality insulation and a major employer of Glenn County, sponsors four (4) \$1000 scholarships: One \$1000 for OHS, one \$1000 for WHS, one \$1000 for HHS, and one \$1000 for Elk Creek, Wm. Finch and Princeton. The two top students who apply from each school will be considered for this scholarship. Students must have a 3.0 or better.

<u>Westside Anglers</u>: A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to any graduate from a Glenn County high school with a career goal in Fish and Wildlife, Conservation or Biology.

Willows Car and Bike Show: A total of \$2500 in scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors from any of the (7) high schools in Glenn County. The requirements are: Two (2) letters of Recommendation, one (1) from an educator, one (1) from a non-school community member (neither should be from a relative). A typed essay why you feel you should be selected; your plans and goals after you complete your educations, and what its attainment will mean to your community/society.

Porter Memorial Scholarship: One (1) \$1500 scholarship will be awarded to a deserving graduate from any Glenn County High School who will be attending a college or trade school for a skilled trade.

<u>Colusa-Glenn Farm Credit</u>: A \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating student from WHS, OHS, ECH, Prov. HHS, and Wm. Finch who majoring in agriculture, agriculture business or Ag. teaching. A GPA of 2.5 or higher is required.

<u>Glenn Chorale:</u> \$500 scholarship, up to three (3) winners will be selected from any Glenn County High School. Student must take a music related class in the first two years of college, verified by the transcript.

<u>Glenn County Scholarship Foundation:</u> A \$200 scholarship will be awarded to a student in each of the high schools in Glenn County.

Ellen Hamann Scholarship: A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating student from any Glenn County high school going into the education field. A typed one-page essay on the history of Glenn County must be submitted with the application.

Glenn Amateur Radio Society (GARS) Science and Technology Scholarship Fund: Two (2) separate \$500 scholarships will be awarded to applicants (high school or older) from Glenn County who have career goals involving science or technology. Preference will be given to those with a 2.5 GPA and a plan to enter trade school. While an amateur radio license of Technician Class or higher license is not required, persons having such license will be given preference.

ELK CREEK HIGH SCHOOL

<u>Chad Langford Memorial Scholarship</u>: A \$500 scholarship for an Elk Creek High graduate demonstrating financial need and a 3.0 GPA. If no 3.0 students apply, 2.5 GPA will be considered.

<u>Elk Creek Community Grange</u> A \$200 scholarship will be awarded to a graduate of Elk Creek High School with a 3.0 GPA.

HAMILTON HIGH SCHOOL

Lake PTO Scholarship: A \$1000 scholarship for a graduate of Hamilton High or Orland High School who is also an eighth grade graduate of Lake Elementary, and has been involved in sports, FFA, 4-H and or other community projects. Must include a short essay explaining the following:

What does Lake School mean to you and how has it influenced you in high school both academically and socially?

<u>Capay Farms Scholarship:</u> A \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a graduate boy <u>and</u> girl of Hamilton High School. The students must have a 3.6 GPA, and must have participated in athletics. Financial need is not a consideration.

Leroy Dean Memorial Fund: A \$200 scholarship for a graduate of Hamilton High or Orland High school who is also an eighth grade graduate of Lake Elementary school, with a minimum GPA of 2.5.

<u>Wilfred L. Karrer Scholarship</u>: A scholarship (Interest) for a graduate from Hamilton High School who is an outstanding scholar. (\$600 this year)

<u>Cheri Pruett Memorial Scholarship:</u> A \$750 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating student of Hamilton or Orland High school who is also an eighth grade graduate of Lake Elementary school, with a minimum GPA of 3.0. Graduate must have strong community service.

ORLAND HIGH SCHOOL

Lake PTO Scholarship: A \$1000 scholarship for a graduate of Hamilton High or Orland High School who is also an eighth grade graduate of Lake Elementary, and has been involved in sports, FFA, 4-H and or other community projects. Must include a short essay explaining the following:



<u>Irvine and Yvonne Finch Memorial Scholarship</u>: A \$1,000 scholarship will be given to an Orland High School graduate demonstrating financial need and who has a strong community service or work experience.

Brad Jasper Memorial Scholarship: A \$500 for a graduate of Orland High School. An award will be given to a student taking into consideration their goals, financial need along with their achievements, extracurricular activities, and grades with the intention of attending an accredited college or university. Goals can be vocational or academic both are considered. GPA 2.5 or better.

Leroy Dean Memorial Fund: A \$200 scholarship for a graduate of Hamilton High or Orland High school who is also an eighth grade graduate of Lake Elementary school, with a minimum GPA of 2.5.

<u>Cheri Pruett Memorial Scholarship:</u> A \$750 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating student of Hamilton or Orland High school who is also an eighth grade graduate of Lake Elementary school, with a minimum GPA of 3.0. Graduate must have strong community service.

<u>Class of 1940</u>: Three (3) \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to Willows High School graduates who are planning to pursue an academic course of study, has a minimum GPA of 2.5 or higher and show significant financial need. Additionally, a \$500 Vocational scholarship will be awarded to a student planning to pursue vocational training.

Addendum History: The Glenn County High School Class of 1940, with 60 graduating seniors, started this scholarship in 1981 with the desire to "help those graduating seniors who want to help themselves" by furthering their education. At this time the scholarship will remain active until the year 2020.

<u>Willows Kiwanis:</u> A total of 4-6 scholarships will be awarded for a Willows High School graduates with community service and a 3.50 GPA.

<u>Linda Carney Scholarship:</u> A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a student from Willows High School with a background in community service, financial need and going into the vocational field.

F.D. Sweet and Son Scholarship: Two \$250 scholarships will be awarded to WHS graduates who have declared a major. The student must write an essay explaining what school they want or are going to attend and why.
