

Glenn County Special Education Local Plan**SELPA Policy****Surrogate Parents**

In order to protect the rights of students with disabilities, local districts shall appoint a surrogate parent to represent a student with disabilities whenever:

- the parents of the student are not known,
- the district cannot, after reasonable efforts, locate the parents,
- the student is a ward of the state, the rights of the parent to make educational decisions has been limited or terminated and the court has not appointed a person to represent the student in educational matters OR
- the child is an unaccompanied homeless youth as defined in section 725(6) of the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act.

The SELPA shall develop procedures for recruiting and training adults to serve as surrogate parents.
